

- Validator Service
 - □ 2 steps:
 - validation (compatibility testing)
 - requirement: <u>OAI-PMH</u>, metadata schema (<u>DublinCore</u>/<u>DataCite</u>)
 - registration
 - requirement: inclusion in registries (OpenDOAR/re3data)
- OpenAIRE Guidelines
 - □ help repository managers expose publications, datasets and CRIS metada the OAI-PMH protocol in order to integrate with OpenAIRE infrastructure.

OpenDOAR



- global Directory of Open Access Repositories
- hosts repositories that provide free, open access to academic outputs and resources
- reviewed and monitored by an editorial team
- registration request via <u>on-line form</u>, assessment against <u>inclusion</u> criteria:
 - access: open access, free, full version, no barriers, worldwide, reliable
 - □ content: academic outputs; NOT aggregator, e-journal or library catalogue
- review and update repository record metadatavia Record Update Request






- □ re3data.org : global registry of research data repositories
- presents repositories for the permanent storage and access of data sets to researchers, funding bodies, publishers and scholarly institutions
- □ registration request via <u>on-line form</u>, assessment against registration policy:
- □ to be registered in re3data.org a research data repository must
 - □ be run by a **legal entity**, such as a sustainable institution (e.g. library, university)
 - clarify access conditions to the data and repository as well as the terms of use
 - have focus on research data
