

- 1 pre-production environment




Next Steps



- Start building NOSCIs:
 - A NOSCI is envisaged as **a coalition of national organisations** that have a prominent role and interest in the European Open Science Cloud (EOSC).
- a) Invite Stakeholders or restart stale groups or discussions
- b) Communicate/engage with relevant government officials
- c) Discuss how the NOSCI will operate and draft the MoU (or other).
- d) Push to become the mandated organisation as NOSCI (or similar).

Indicative Deadlines - Groups



• Group 1:

The countries that have already had discussion about NOSCI with government officials, but progress has been stalled due to political reasons (elections, changes in relevant Ministry, etc.) (Bulgaria, Cyprus, Georgia, Montenegro, Serbia)

• Group 2:

The countries that do **not** have an established working NOSCI team. (Albania, Armenia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Hungary, Romania, Moldova, N. Macedonia)

• Group 3:

The countries with an established working NOSCI team. (Greece, Slovenia)
