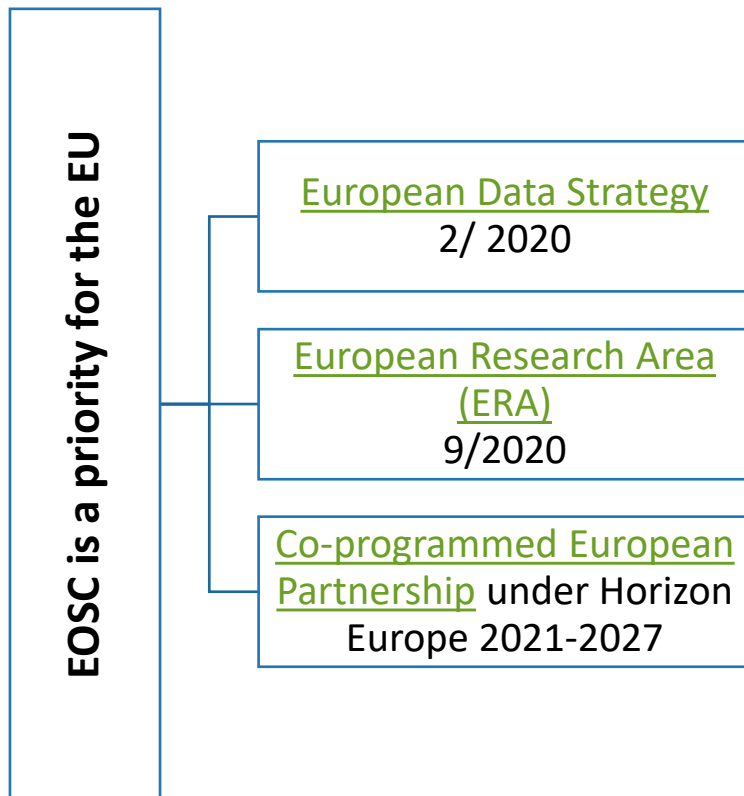

EOSC took shape in 2015 to federate existing research data infrastructures to support and develop open science and open innovation.



European Data Strategy

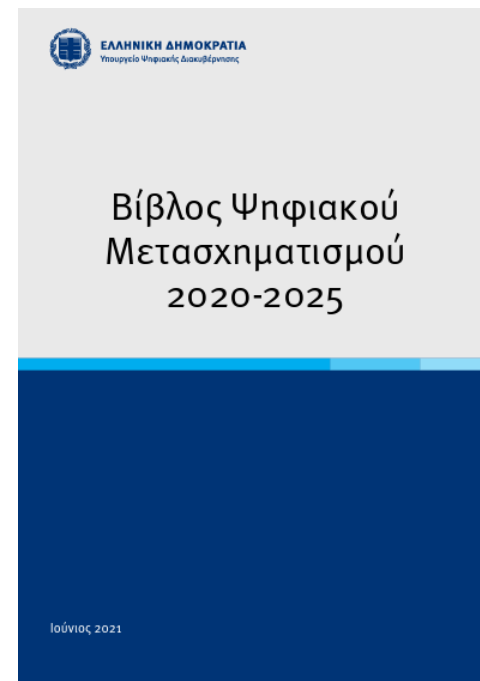
- by 2025 deploy EOSC operations to serve EU researchers.
- from 2024 open up, connect and articulate EOSC beyond the research communities, with the wider public sector and the private sector.

European Research Area

- One of the 14 actions introduced in the ERA Communication consists of ensuring an EOSC that is offering a web of FAIR data and related services.

Bible for Digital Transformation

- Ministry of Digital Governance
- Latest policy document in Greece, takes into account all the elements to advance the national Open Science Cloud ecosystem and engage with the EOSC.
- Strengthening the national electronic infrastructures and digital research services, to interconnecting them with the European Open Science Cloud infrastructures.
- Open Access for scientific publications, research data and software
- Empower the Greek R&D community with the necessary qualifications, digital skills, incentives and reward mechanisms for the adoption of Open Science at national level.
- It was a success of the Greek Task Force on Open Science that produced the National Plan of Open Science in Greece and was supported by NI4OS-Europe.

Governing bodies

EOSC Governance Board

- representatives from EU countries, countries associated with Horizon 2020 and the Commission
- ensures effective supervision of the EOSC implementation.

EOSC Executive Board

- representatives from the research and e-infrastructures communities.
- ensures the implementation and accountability.

EOSC Stakeholder Forum

- organised by the EOSC secretariat is formed by representatives from a wider range of actors, tasked to provide input and recommendations through events and online consultation mechanisms.

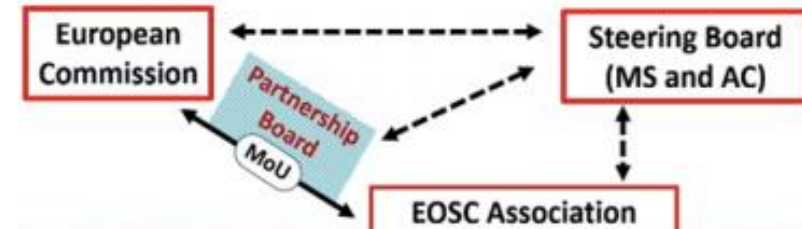

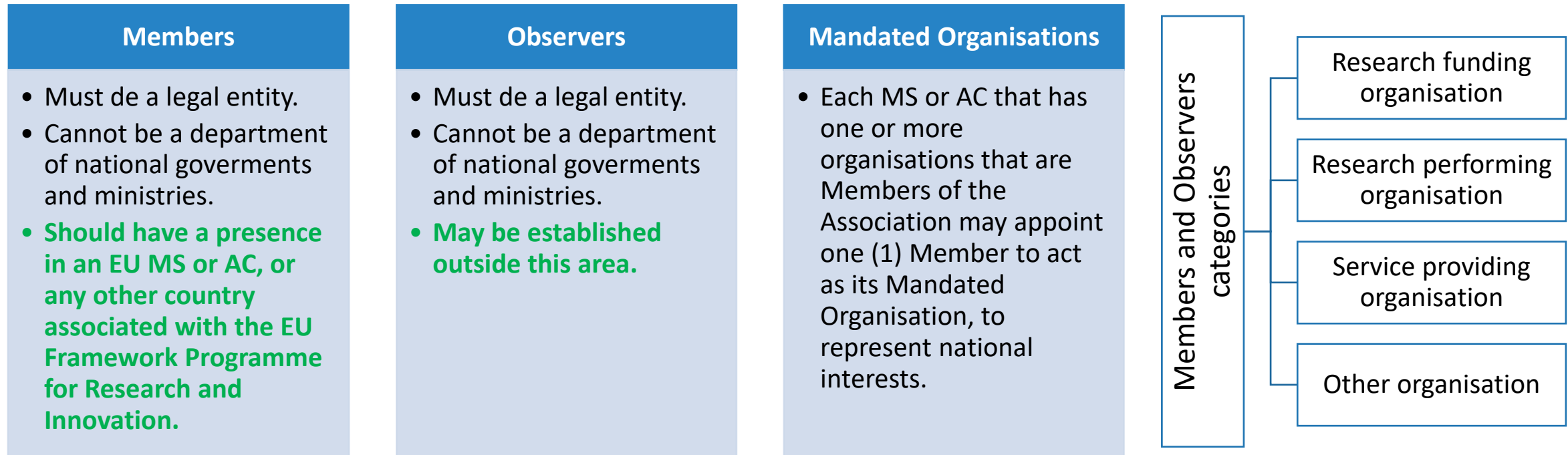

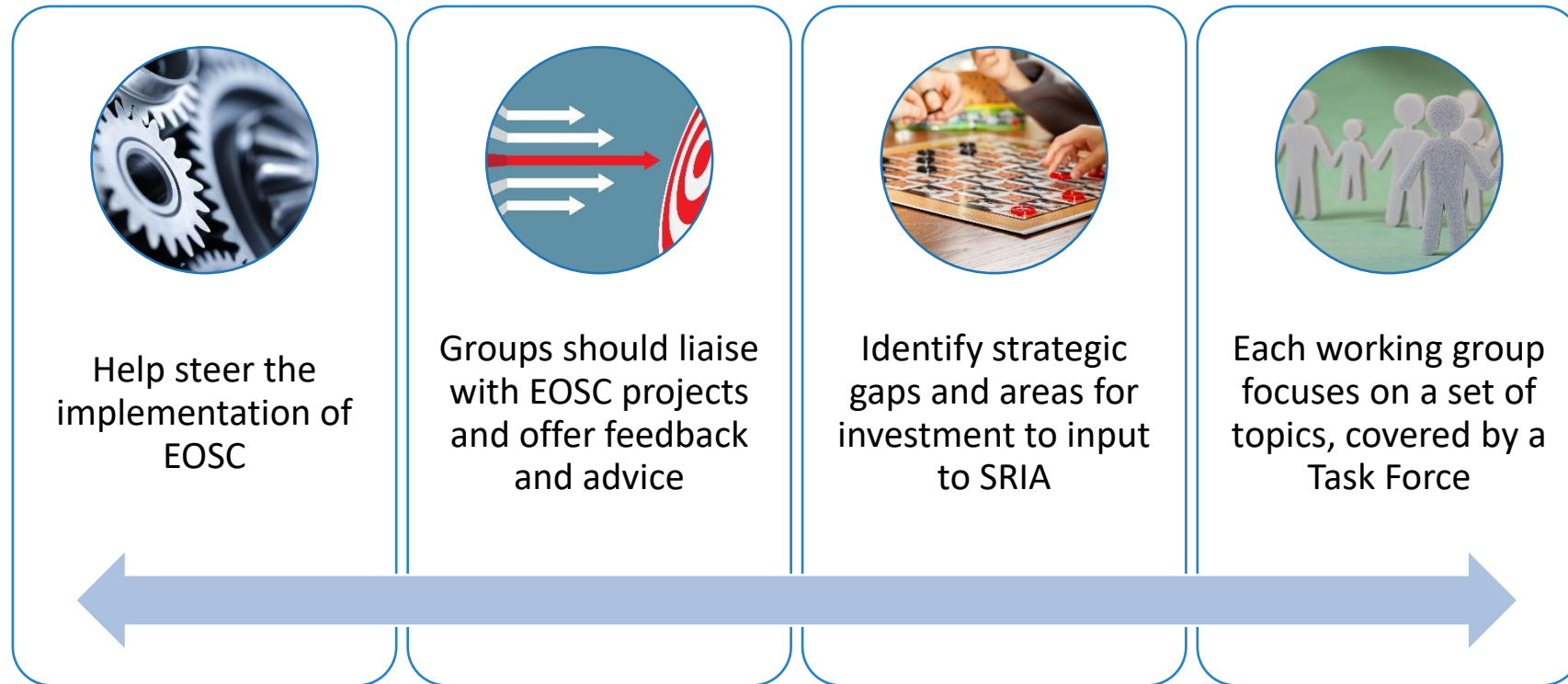

EOSC core documentation

NI4OS-Europe supported the members of the EOSC Governance Board (GB), Executive Board (EB), EOSC working groups and individual partners and provided input for several EOSC core documents such as for the FAIR Lady (olim Iron Lady) report, the Strategic Research and Innovation Agenda (SRIA) and the EOSC partnership proposal.

Participation in the EOSC Task Forces

NI4OS-Europe representatives participated actively at the Landscape, Architecture, Skills & Training and Sustainability Working Groups and at the Landscape, Service on Boarding (chair), National Policies (chair), FAIR data and Infrastructures, Dissemination & Events, Training and skills Task Forces and now participate to the newly created Advisory Groups.

NI4OS-Europe supported the development of numerous reports and participated directly to the EOSC Working Groups and now participates to the EOSC Advisory Groups.

Support to the Establishment of the EOSC Association

NI4OS-Europe members were taking part in the development and drafting of the EOSC Association Statutes. After the signature of the Statutes, NI4OS-Europe representatives participated officially to the EOSC Association Bylaws Working Group (WG).

Researchers

Widen the opportunities for collaboration and facilitate sharing and re-use research data-not only across research projects but also across sectors and countries

Allow researchers, with limited resources, to draw from this pool of data and services, compensate for national gaps, and develop their research

Policy

EOSC connects to stakeholders from other regions of Europe and thereby facilitates the sharing of knowledge and experiences

Countries that are already advanced in FAIR data and Open Science policies can share their best practices and lead in developing EOSC

Economic

The sharing of resources and services creates economies of scale

Federating existing research services and data infrastructures, EOSC will leverage national and european investments
